

UNDERTAKING
for enhancement of MBBS seats at GGS Medical College, Faridkot (Punjab),
constituent Medical College of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot from 100 to 150

1. The applicant Government of Punjab is running the Guru Gobind Singh Medical College & Hospital at Faridkot as constituent Medical College of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences Faridkot with an annual intake capacity of 50 MBBS seats till 2012-13 session and has been permitted 100 admissions from the current academic session 2013-14, vide LOP issued by MCI No.MCI-37(1)(1-7)2013-Med./20109 dated 10.7.2013. The Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot has been granted initial Letter of Permission by the Central Government on 17.9.1991 and as on date it has completed ten years of Standing from the date of grant of initial Letter of Permission. The MBBS qualification awarded by the applicant Medical College is included in the First Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.
2. The applicant Government of Punjab is desirous of increasing this capacity to 150 seats annually.
3. The applicant in case it is granted permission to enhance the seats to 150 would ensure that by the time of first and subsequent renewals of permission the human resources and physical infrastructure of the said Medical College would be augmented in accordance with the requirements of Regulations.
4. The applicant assures that the compliance with the relevant Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations is mandatory for continuation of the batch of students and is in the interest of students. In case of any failure to meet the requirements of the Regulations the Central Government / Board of Governors in super-session of the Medical Council of India would be entitled in law to withdraw/revoke/cancel such permission.
