Subject:- Essentiality Certificate / No Objection Certificate to Start Master of Physiotherapy Course in 3 (three) subjects i.e. i) Sports-4 seats, ii) Orthopedics-4 seats, iii) Cardiology Respiratory-4 seats - Dashmesh College of Physiotherapy, Talwandi Road, Faridkot.

Reference on the subject cited above.

2. Essentiality Certificate / No Objection Certificate is issued in favour of the Dashmesh College of Physiotherapy, Talwandi Road, Faridkot to start Master of Physiotherapy course in 3 (three) subject with an intake of 12 (Twelve) seats 4 (four) seats in each subject i.e. i) Sports-4 seats, ii) Orthopedics-4 seats, iii) Cardiology Respiratory-4 seats) in their institution, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) The Institute will get affiliation with the concerned University/ Indian Association of Physiotherapists, New Delhi as the case may be and also will get permission of the Government before making admissions.
- ii) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government instructions issued from time to time.
- iii) The pay scales and emoluments of their staff shall be as per Punjab Government pay scales.
- iv) The inspection of the institute shall be carried out on yearly basis upto the completion of the study of first batch of the students. Thereafter, the inspection shall be periodical after three years.
- v) The admission shall be done as per criteria fixed by the Punjab Government from time to time.
- vi) The project is to be implemented as per the approved project report within the prescribed time.
- vii) The Punjab Government will have the right to withdraw the Essentiality Certificate/ No Objection Certificate if the Society/applicant fails to meet any of the conditions of Essentiality Certificate/ No Objection Certificate.
- viii) The construction work shall be completed within one year and admission shall be made within 2 years of the issue of Essentiality Certificate/ No Objection Certificate.

2. This Essentiality Certificate / No Objection Certificate issues with the approval of the competent authority.
