Reference to your letter No. CMCH/PO/ESTB/2016/ 200 dated 27-9-2016 on the subject cited above.

Chintpurni Medical College was given NOC by Punjab Government for starting Medical College vide letter No. 2/88/2010-2HB3/8368 dated 7-12-2010 and revised letter No. 2/88/2010-2HB3/1416 dated 15-2-2011 and was affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot vide letter No. 06(BFUHS)\_DEO4\_CM5(10)/34659 dated 10-12-2010.

Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, (Department of Health & Family Welfare), Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi vide Notification No. U.12012/33/2016-ME.1 dated 26-09-2016 states that: -

**"M.B.B.S.**

*(This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Chintpurni Medical Colleges and Hospital, Pathankot, Punjab with annual intake of 150 MBBS students on or after 2016.)"*

As per your letter in reference and affidavit by Dr. R. C. Sharma, (Dean), it has been stated by you that aforesaid College has complied with all the terms and conditions laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court mandated Oversight Committee and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India. Permission to admit students in MBBS course is accorded subject to fulfillment of all conditions & guidelines by Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, Medical Council of India, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and Hon'ble Supreme Court mandated Oversight Committee as issued from time to time.

**NOTIFICATION**

S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of the section 11 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the said Act:

(a) In the said First Schedule after "Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot" and under the heading 'Recognized Medical Qualification' [Hereinafter referred to as column (2)], after the last entry and entry relating thereto under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [Hereinafter referred to as column (3)], the following shall be inserted, namely:-

Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery	M.B.B.S.  (This shall be a recognized medical qualification when granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Chintpurni Medical College and Hospital, Pathankot, Punjab with annual intake of 150 MBBS students on or after 2016.

Note: 1. This Notification is issued complying with the direction of the Supreme Court Mandated Oversight Committee on MCI as communicated vide letter No. OC/Approval for 2016-17/116 dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2016. The Medical College shall, provide the following:-

- (i) An affidavit from the Dean/Principal and Chairman of the Trust/University/Society/Company etc concerned, affirming fulfillment of all deficiencies and statements made in the respective compliance report submitted to MHFW (by 27.09.2016)
- (ii) A bank guarantee in the amount of Rs. 2 crore in favour of MCI, which will be valid for 1 year or until the first renewal assessment, whichever is later. Such bank guarantee will be in addition to the prescribed fee submitted alongwith the application (by 27.09.2016).

2. The Supreme Court Mandated Oversight Committee while granting approval has also stipulated as follows:-

- (a) OC may direct inspection to verify the compliance submitted by the college and considered by OC, any time after 30 September 2016
- (b) In default of the conditions (i) and (ii) in 1 above and if the compliances are found incomplete in the inspection to be conducted after 30 September 2016, such college will be debarred from fresh intake of students for 2 years commencing 2017-18.

3. The College is further directed to:


- a) Upload on its website the status of compliance with MSRs in respect of faculty, infrastructure, clinical material, bed occupancy and other requirements as on 10th September, 2016 in the first instance followed by another update on the website as on 20th September, 2016 and the status may be intimated to OC.
- b) Maintain and display the following details of its website for at least 3 months, in order to ensure transparency in admission to UG/PG (Super Speciality) courses for the academic year 2016-17:
  - i. Name of candidate
  - ii. Roll Number
  - iii. NEET Ranking
  - iv. State Ranking and
  - v. Amount of fee paid for admission to the course

A copy of the details so uploaded in each case by the institute on its respective website may be furnished by the institute to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Medical Council of India. The Notification/Approval is subject to complying with the above directives of OC.

4. The recognition so granted to undergraduate courses for award of MBBS degree shall be subject to directives and stipulations made by the Oversight Committee indicated herein above and further subject to a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed. The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award for recognition.

5. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned undergraduate Course.
